Friday 2 June 10am to 4pm #	JELLY ROLL AND CHARM SQUARE QUILT Use pre-cuts to make a single bed size quilt. This is one of our early patterns and it remains very popular as it goes together quickly to make a single bed size quilt.	£37
Friday 16 June 10am to 4pm ###	APPLIQUE HEART CUSHION Learn machine applique and make this pretty cushion.	£37
Tuesday 20 June 10am to 4pm ###	CUTTING MAT BAG Make a padded bag with front pocket for carrying your cutting mat and rulers to workshops.	£37
Friday 14 July 10am to 4pm	UFO DAY Do you need to make some progress on something you started in one of our classes and haven't finished yet? This is the ideal day for you. Ann is on hand to help throughout. Class size limited to 6.	£15
Tuesday 18 July 10am to 4pm NEW DESIGN	STRIPPY SQUARES Use various sizes of strips and scraps plus two co-ordinating fabrics to make a flexibly sized block/quilt. No fixed strip or block sizes mean that every quilt will be different!	£37
Friday 28 July 10am to 4pm NEW DESIGN	ENGLISH PAPER PIECING (BUT NOT AS YOU KNOW IT!) Learn the art of hand sewing over paper templates to create a small design which you can grow into a larger item if you get the bug. You may have seen some very complex Millefiori designs in magazines and this is an ideal introduction to the skills needed to make a complex design.	£37
Friday 11 August 10am to 4pm	UFO DAY Do you need to make some progress on something you started in one of our classes and haven't finished yet? This is the ideal day for you. Ann is on hand to help throughout. Class size limited to 6.	£15
Thursday 17 August 10am to 4pm #	CASCADE 2 We haven't run this one for ages – it is a complex design and there are various size options from table runner to king size quilt. NOT SUITABLE FOR BEGINNERS	£37
Tuesday 5 September 10am to 4pm #	BEAUX ARTS LAYER CAKE QUILT Use a Layer cake to make this quilt with a 'bow tie' shaped centre in each block.	£37
Friday 15 September 10am to 4pm #	ZIGZAG TABLE RUNNER AND TABLE MATS Use a Jelly roll or cut your own 2 ½" strips to make this pointed end runner and table mats.	£37
Thursday 19 September 10am to 4pm NEW DESIGN	LAYER CAKE SHUFFLE Use a layer cake and a contrast sashing to make a large lap or throw size quilt. Or you can cut your own squares from 9 fat quarters.	£37
Friday 27 October 10am to 4pm ###	ADVENT CALENDAR/CHRISTMAS CARD HOLDER This was a new design last year. It can either be used as an advent calendar or as an over door hanger to display your Christmas cards.	£37

BY BOOKING A WORKSHOP YOU AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND THESE FORM A BINDING CONTRACT BETWEEN YOU AND US.

Workshop places are limited and are sold in advance. You must be 18 or over to attend a workshop. Beginners' days include all materials and use of our equipment including sewing machines. Other workshop fees do not include materials and do not include the use of our equipment. We will send you a requirements list of materials and equipment shortly before the workshop: this usually includes an image of the project if it is not on display in the shop. Examples of new designs will not be available to see in the shop until shortly before the day of the workshop.

Unless otherwise stated, workshops run from 10am until 4pm with a 30-45 minute lunch break. Unless otherwise stated, if you can use a rotary cutter with confidence, all workshops are suitable for all skill levels.

We have several sewing machines, which can be reserved for use in some workshops if you are unable to bring a machine. These are available on a first come first served basis, they must be reserved in advance and are charged at £6 per day plus the cost of any breakages. They are **not** available for machine quilting or applique classes.

We reserve the right to cancel any workshop at any time for any reason, in which case we will give you as much notice as possible and refund any fee you have paid. However, we accept no liability for any other costs which you may incur.

Payment is required in full at the time of booking to reserve a place.

NB We do not refund payments for workshops. If you wish to cancel a booking and notify us at least 28 days prior to the date of the workshop we will attempt to fill your place and, if successful, we will credit you with the fee paid to allow you to book another workshop. If, however, we cannot resell your place your fee will be forfeited.

Once classes are full, we operate a reserve list and if there are sufficient numbers we may schedule another date.

Other than beginners' days, most workshops do not result in a fully completed item on the day but full instructions are given to enable you to complete the project at home. Except for beginners' days, workshops do not provide any tuition on rotary cutting and assume that you are able to use a rotary cutter with confidence and that you have your own rotary cutting equipment.

We do not permit the use of any electrical items other than sewing machines on our premises. We will make a visual check of your sewing machine before we permit you to use it in the shop and reserve the right to refuse if we consider your machine is unsafe to use.

We accept no liability for loss or damage to your possessions.

We reserve the right to refuse bookings and to ask you to leave the shop if you are causing harm, upset or offence to any member of staff or customers.

Please note that our premises, the entrance lobby and the mill yard area outside are our shop are non-smoking including the use of e-cigarettes.

Workshops taught by Ann Mayner are exclusive to Quiltessential and have been designed by Darren and Ann Mayner. Darren produces the patterns with clear, detailed instructions and illustrations. He also considers fabric efficiency when designing and the fabric requirements on these patterns have been carefully worked out.
